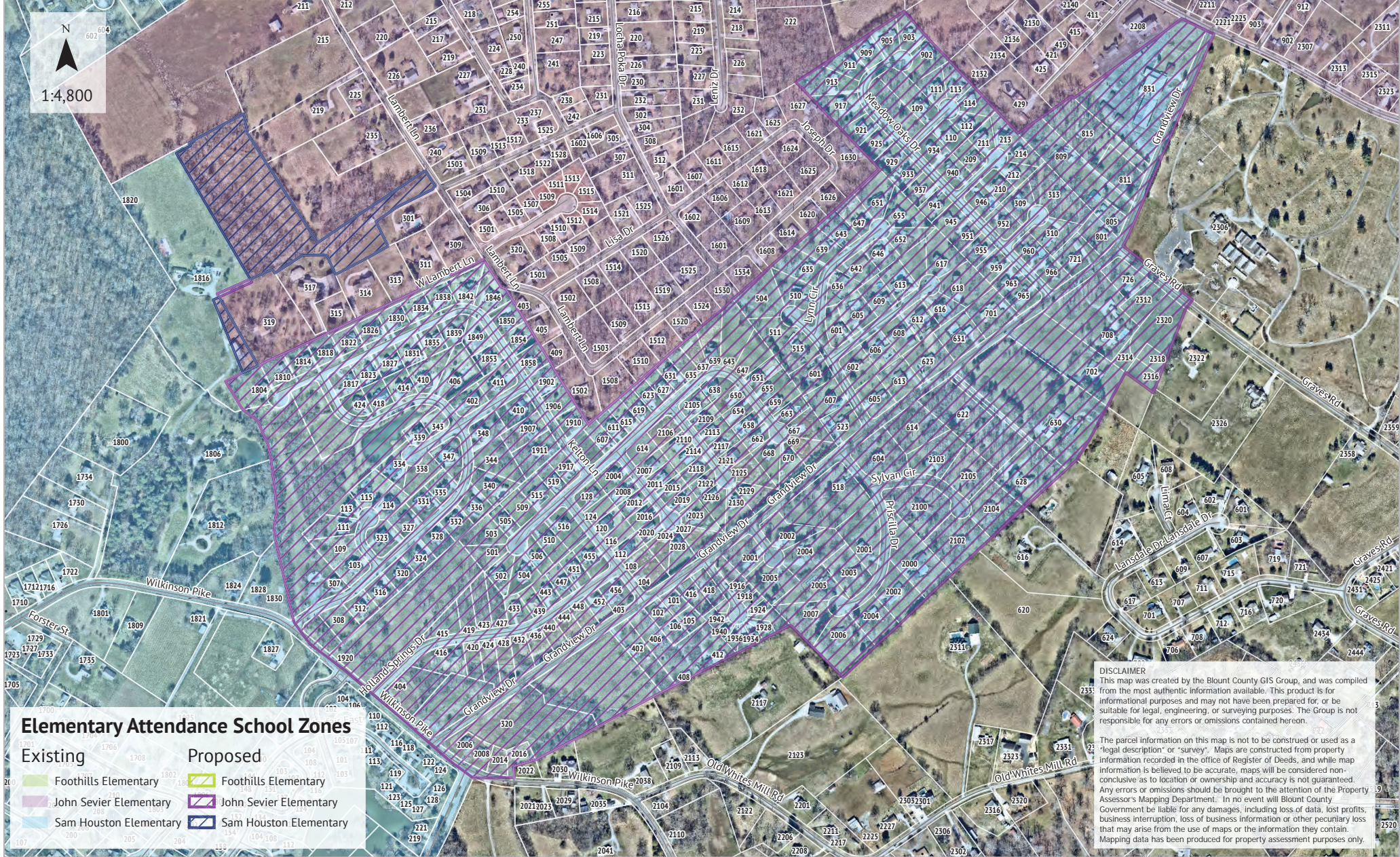

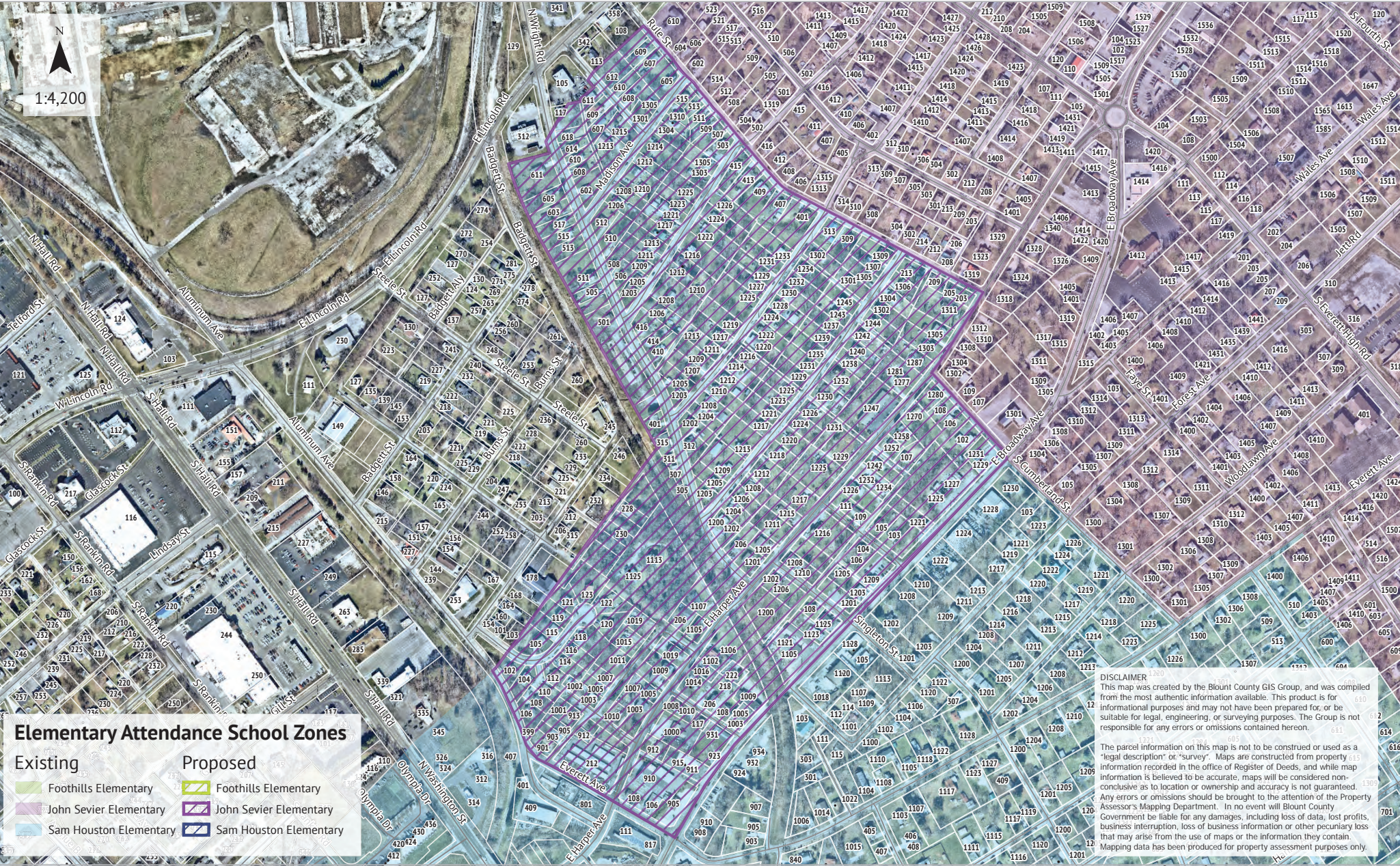


# Maryville City Schools - Elementary School Rezoning (Area 1)
