Maryville City Schools operates three Integrated Pre-K classes at each of the following elementary schools: John Sevier Elementary, Foothills Elementary, and Sam Houston Elementary. In addition, classes at the Early Intervention Center (campus of JSE) also utilize peer models to support children with special needs. Children must qualify to attend a program as a peer model:

#### **Eligibility:**

- (1) One parent or grandparent must be a current employee of Maryville City Schools
- (2) Student must be 4 years of age, but not yet 5 by August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023, for Integrated Pre-K and *at least* 3 years old by August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023 for the Early Intervention Center PreK Experience (priority for EIC PreK Experience will be 4 year-olds)
- (3) Above average development in communication, and behavior, and social skills and toilet trained
- (4) Family must provide transportation

#### **Guidelines:**

- Completion of developmental checklists. After the adjustment period, a child may be removed from the program if they demonstrate any pattern of inappropriate behaviors and/or demonstrate delays in communication and/or social skills. Applicants may be asked to attend a short in-person screening for developmental appropriateness.
- Follow Maryville City Schools attendance policy for Integrated Pre-K peer models.
- Parents must have their children at the program on time and pick them up at the designated time.
- Pay tuition by the 5<sup>th</sup> of each month (\$250/month for IPK and \$75/month for EIC PreK)
- Responsibility of lunch and snacks will be incurred by the parents/guardians (IPK only)

Submission of the Peer model Pre-K application is not a guarantee of acceptance into the program. Once the application, income verification, and proof of residency are submitted, the Director of Schools or his/her designee will determine the eligibility of students based on the guidelines and priorities stated above. Some enrollment decisions will not be finalized until mid to late July. After the classes have reached capacity, eligible students will be placed on a waiting list.
